INCREASINGLY COMPLEX DOMESTIC CASES "A declining economy exacerbates marital difficulties," notes Kazarosian. "Traps in evaluating closely held corporations and LLCs, unstable real estate values and deteriorating investments all contribute to

the adversarial nature of domestic cases. However, as counselors we also have to respect the value of a resolution by agreement."
